<b>General</b> At the beginning, briefly introduce yourself and give your domestic help the opportunity to introduce themselves.
Please tell us something about yourself.
How long have you been working as a domestic helper?
<b>Tasks</b> Explain what tasks will be involved and what your expectations are. Do you want your domestic helper to clean for you or, for example, also iron, cook or do the shopping? Before the interview, get an idea of of how much work will be involved and discuss this with the domestic help. Does their profile fit the tasks involved?
What experience do you have that is relevant to the tasks involved?
In what time frame do you think the tasks described can be done?
Are there any tasks that you do not want to or cannot do?

## **Availability & payment**

Clarify the framework of the employment relationship.

On which days are you available? For how many hours? At what intervals?
Do you want to work as an employee or are you self-employed?
